First national Holstein sale at Oakville since the U.S. embargo was lifted brought disappointing results to cattle owners.

Average price for 61 animals sold was \$674, lowest in years. Previous high average price topped \$1,000. Of the animals sold 34 went to U.S. buyers.

tor. His six-month-old bull, Glen-afton Potentate, was purchased for \$1,950 by W. T. Craig Reid, Norval, and will be shipped to a Mexican buyer.
