

Mural Dedicated to World Peace Unveiled at U.N.



A huge mural covering a curved wall over 60 feet long and 10 feet high was recently unveiled at United Nations Headquarters. Painted in tempera directly on a canvas-covered wall by Jose Vela Zanetti, Director of the National School of Fine Arts of the Dominican Republic, it depicts man's eternal struggle for lasting peace. The mural is the gift of the Guggenheim Foundation, under whose fellowship the 39-year old Spanish-born artist worked.
