Build Four Store Block on Highway Near Normandy

A block of four new stores on No. 7 east of Harrison's Garage is almost ready for occupancy.

The stores, of cement block construction with modern brick fronts, are being erected by Rev. F. M. Fletcher of Georgetown and a Toronto barrister, C. C. Downey and will be offered for sale.

Each store is 50 feet deep with eighteen-foot frontage on the highway. They have been erected on vacant land formerly owned by Norman Snyder. Mr. Fletcher reports that already one potential storekeeper has been in touch with him, and he figures there will be a demand for this type of business building in this fast growing section of town.

Mr. Fletcher came to Georgetown earlier this year, purchasing the old Brill Woolen Mill building from William Schenk. He has since converted this into his church, which is called Zion Tabernacle, with apartments upstairs and a large downstairs apartment for his own family.

Charge Erin Youth With Uncle's Murder

Jeffrey Robertson, 21, of Erin has been charged with the murder of his uncle, John Mackie, who died early Saturday morning from wounds from a .22 calibre rifle.

Robertson was apprehended after an intensive search, by fifty provincial police through swampy bushland and barns in the Erin-Belfountain area. He was found in the barn on the farm three miles northeast of Erin where the shooting took place, shortly before noon on Saturday.

The killing occurred after a heated argument between the two men which occurred about 2 o'clock in the morning. Mackie was shot twice and died instantly, and Robertson fled from the house, taking the rifle with him. Apparently he had hidden in the barn while the search was going on. He surrendered with the rifle when found in a haymow.
