Mr. Russell happened to be up in his cabin at the time and the force of the impact knocked him off his feet. No one was injured, he reports, and there was no panic, though of course all the passengers rushed on deck. A remembered part of their voyage to England, which was also made on the Samaria, was their observance of their 45th wedding anniversary, when a special wedding cake was placed on their table through the courtesy of the steamship line. In England, Mr. and Mrs. Russell spent some time in the Stoke-On-Trent district, and also visited Scotland and the Isle of Man.
