Amend Hydro Change Dates for Georgetown

The Ont. Hydro Commission has varied by approximately three months the tentatively-planned dates for changeover to 60-cycle frequency of Georgetown, Brampton, Acton, Milton, Campbellville, Streetsville and surrounding areas. Announcing this recently, Hydro Chairman Robert H. Saunders stated that this rearrangement of originally planned standardization periods for these municipalities has been dictated by the unusually rapid development in industry, commerce and home building around Waterdown and the Burlington Rural Operating Area.

Mr. Saunders said a heavy load growth would result from these developments, and it was necessary to take up this new load at 60 cycles in order to avoid the costly task of converting it from 25 cycles to the higher frequency in the near future.

The amended schedule for the affected section of Ontario Hydro's standardization area "L", is as follows:—

Georgetown Hydro Electric Commission: First two weeks of September, 1954.
Brampton Rural Operating Area — Glen Williams Distributing Station, Last two weeks in September, 1954; Brampton D.S., Last week of November and first week of December, 1954; Milton D.S. — First two weeks of Jan., 1955; Streetsville D.S., last two weeks in Jan., 1955.

Acton Public Utilities Commission — First two weeks of October, 1954.

Brampton Hydro Electric Commission — Last two weeks October and first three weeks of November, 1954.

Guelph Rural Operating Area — (Acton Distributing Station No. 1) Second week of October, 1954.

Milton Hydro-Electric Commission — Second and third weeks of December, 1954.

Campbellville Hydro System — Last week of December, 1954.
Streetsville Public Utilities Commission — Second week of January, 1955.

Mr. Saunders said that inventory of power customers' plants in these municipalities is now proceeding, but the changeover schedule for industrial equipment has also been amended.

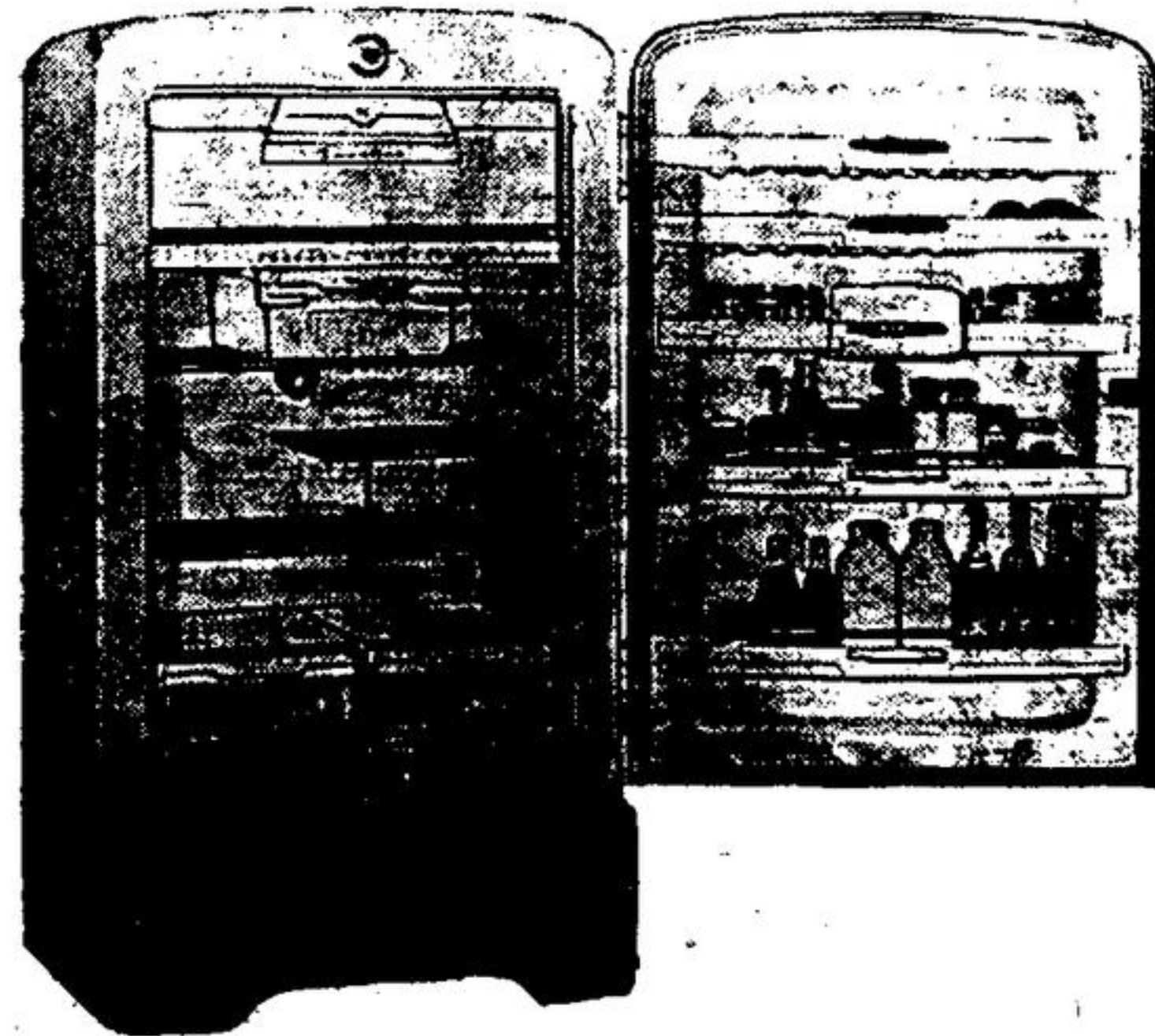

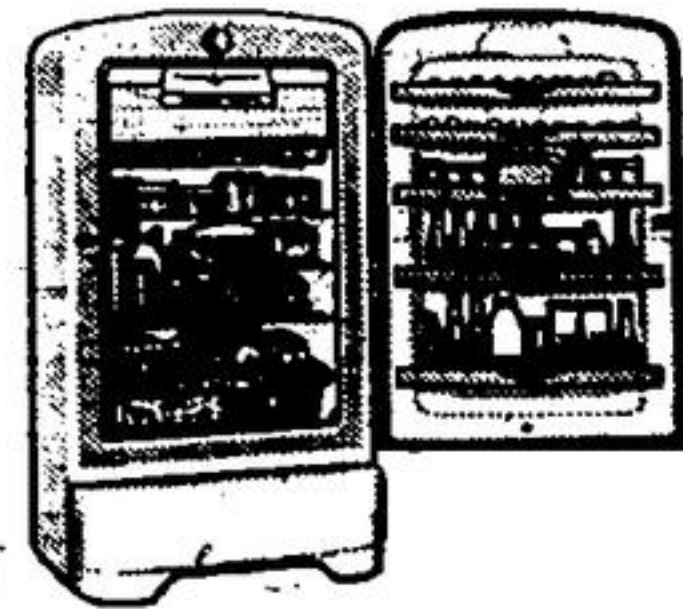
