### Amend Hydro Change Dates for Georgetown

The Ont. Hydro Commission has by approximately three months the tentatively-planned dates for changeover to 60-cycle frequency of Georgetown, Brampton, Milton, Campbellville, Streetsville and surrounding areas. Announcing this recently, Hydro Chairman Robert H. Saunders stated that this rearrangement of oriplanned standarization periods for these municipalities has been dictated by the unusually rapid development in industry, commerce and home building around Waterdown and the Burlington Rural Operating Area.

Mr. Saunders said a heavy load growth would result from these developments, and it was necessary to take up this new load at 60 cycles in order to avoid the costly task of converting it from 25 cycles to the higher frequency in the near future.






