BALLINAFAD Skilled Blacksmith Duncan Ferguson Dies
A skilled tradesman who took great pride in his work as a blacksmith, Duncan Ferguson, 80, was buried in Erin Cemetery following a service in Ballinafad United Church on Thursday. He died at his home the previous Monday.
He was a lifelong resident of the village, with the exception of two years spent in Toronto where he worked with Crow and Murray in the days when horseshoeing occupied a great part of a blacksmith's time.
Born in Ballinafad, he was the son of Peter Ferguson, and Charlotte Belgrave, and obtained his schooling at Blue Mountain School. On December 25th, 1911, he married Ethel Near, who survives, with one son, Fred, a brother Peter who was associated with him in business and two sisters, Mr. Frank Binnie of Lindsay and Mrs. J. T. May. of Markdale. Two sisters predeceased him, Mrs. J. MacDonald, Toronto and Miss Lottie Ferguson. He was a member of Ballinafad United Church.
Mr. Norman Russ conducted the funeral service and pallbearers were Frank Robinson, Stan Allen and Harold Marshall, Georgetown, George McDonald, Maple, Charles Near, Newmarket, and Kerwin Galaway, Port Stanley.
