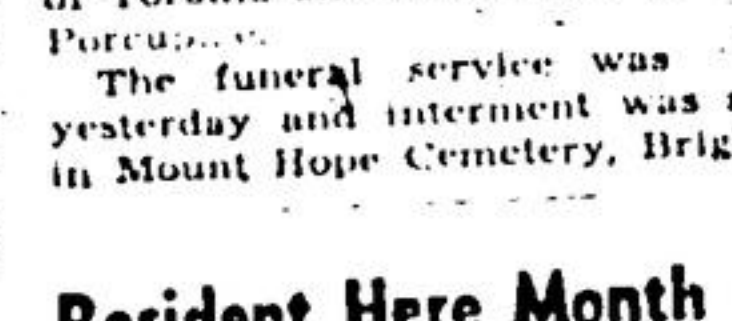
The funeral service was held yesterday and interment was made in Mount Hope Cemetery, Brighton.
