**THE "NEW LOOK" IN TRAVEL**—This is the new sleeping car introduced by the Canadian National Railways. It is of a type never before seen in Canada, and was produced by the CNR following surveys to determine the character of equipment and service sought by the travelling public.  
Known as a 4-8-4 to railroaders, the car has four double bedrooms, eight duplex roomettes and four sections. New in design and style, it offers the ultimate in comfort and safety, and is part of CNR orders for 359 new passenger cars — the largest single purchase of passenger rolling stock in Canadian railway history. This new equipment will soon be seen on CNR trains in all sections of Canada.  
In the new model, two bedrooms may be converted into one large room by folding the partitions and making adjoining rooms en suite. The beds disappear completely during daytime travel into recesses in the wall and ceiling. Arm chairs may be moved to any position in the room.  
For mild (lower photograph) there are stylish dressing tables and china washbasins installed in the bedrooms. A twist of the pre-selector control and a touch of the foot valve provides water at any desired temperature. Each room has its own private toilet annex.  
The eight duplex roomettes, with sofa seats and full-size beds, are in alternating aisle and upper levels at one end of the car. At the opposite end, the "new look" has been carried to the familiar section space. Ladders set up each night with upper berths make it no longer necessary to hang for the porter to step up or down.
