SELF FEEDING OF HOGS PRACTICAL

breeders were recently dispelled when W P Watson, Ontario Live Stock Commissioner and Chairman of the Advanced Registry Test Station Board, reported that tests conducted at the Waterloo Pig Testing Station last year showed that selfteeding of pags did not necessarily result in over-fat careasses and thta feed consumption per pound of gain was if anything, somewhat lower than by hand feeding

It was also revealed that not only had tests brought out these two important facts, but in addition, pigs fed by the self feeder method had been marketed one month earher than those fed by harfd in 1952

"A ration containing about 16 per cent protein is fed until the page average 100 lbs then the ration to changed to one containing about 14 per cent protein, stated Mr Watson 'Although self feeding has been condemned on the grounds that it tends to produce pigs carrying too much lat, such criticism is scarcely justified on the basis of the 1953 results at the Pig Testing Station As a matter of fact 444 or 69.7 per cent of the 636 pigs thatcompleted the test qualified for A grade During that same period only 32.2 per cent of Ontario's market hogs were classified in the top grade. Our readers will also be interested to learn that at the test station under the self feeding method, one pound of gain was produced with 3.5 pounds of feed - this marks the highest rate of feed efficiency obtained in any year since the station was established.

"Despite the fact that Ontario's pure bred pigs make a very creditable showing when subjected to the A. R. test, two weaknesses were exposed upon analysis of the careass,' stated Mr. Watson. The two factors were length and back fat. Since these characteristics are inherited breeders should select additions to their breeds from strains that have high scores for length and back fat.
