### \$681 AVERAGE AT NATIONAL SALE

\$681 was the average figure realized for 47 head at the 1954 National Holstein Sale held at Hays Sales Arena, on Monday of last week. Highest figure of the day was \$1500, for a six months old bull calf consigned by J. M. Fraser of Streetsville. The calf in question was sired by A. B. C. Reflection Sovereign out of a McCaugherty bred 20,000 lb. daughter of Inka Supreme Reflection. F. O. Hunter, Norval, and Ashville Farms Ltd. were the only Halton consignors. Their two year old heifers each sold at a \$550 figure. Sam Finnie of Hornby was the only Halton buyer, getting a nice uddered springing two year old grand-daughter of Montvic Lochinvar 3rd out of a 600 lb. fat daughter of Woodland Fayne Hello King. It is reported that 31 of the 47 head were purchased by buyers from U.S. and South America.
