### Radio Quartette Sings At First Baptist Church

At the morning worship at the First Baptist Church, Rev. A. J. Barker chose Acts 6: 3 "Wherefore brethren look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom" — comparing the tasks of the church in the time of the disciples to duties of church officers of today. At first a deacon's task was of social service but later it was to aid in the spiritual life. The Christian church has a right to expect men and women of sterling character who are in full relationship with Jesus Christ. The prime function in life is to witness for Jesus Christ. We need men of wisdom to know the indwelling spirit of God in the hearts of men. The rewards of service are growth and maturity in Christian character. At the conclusion of the service there was the installation of the Deacon's Board and reception of new members. The choir's anthem was "Come Ye Disciples".

At the evening service Mr. Barker preached on "The Descent of the Spirit" — relating how the ascension of our Lord came to communitate those of the universe who had Jesus central in their lives. The Holy Spirit must be regarded as a person, not seen visibly but who is always present. This had been the experience of the early Christians because they felt the power of Christ in their lives and so it is the experience of men and women of the present day. We do not need to pray for the Holy Spirit to come as life is present for all who desire it, but we must pray for us to be led by the Holy Spirit. God has not retired from the scene of man's activity but he is present through the works of the Holy Spirit. The spirit of God is ever here for His people to witness to their souls, it is no vague influence, but God himself in all His power, and never ceases as long as there is human need. The full complement of a Christian is to be full of the spirit of God and who is known in a living relationship. His energies are at work for a new motive in life. The test of discovering if a person is a Christian is not by doing good works or having an orthodox belief, but one that has the spirit of Christ in his heart by a complete commitment of his life to Him. "If any man hath not the spirit of Christ he is not His".

Special guests at this service were the "Forwardaires" quartette of Toronto, who are so widely known for their ministry and witness to their Lord through their message in song, heard each Sunday morning over station CFRB.
