WHAT COUNCIL DID

Building Inspector Will Investigate Dog Complaint
Council at Monday's meeting was sympathetic to a complaint lodged by Bruce Harley about a dog in his neighbourhood which he claimed had consistently caused trouble. The dog, he said, had bitten two children and a grown-up, howls when it is tied up in the basement and frightens people when it is let loose at night. Requests to the owner have been ignored, he continued and he appealed to council for some solution.
It was decided that the matter comes under a section of the building by-law. The clerk was instructed to have Inspector George Adams investigate and report to the next council meeting on the 16th.

Tax and water arrears deemed uncollectible for a variety of reasons, were written off.
