Visits Austrian Homeland After 24 Years in Canada

Visiting his native land for the first time since he came to this country, John Lenz will be reunited this week with his brother and sisters in Oestermark, Austria.

It is his first visit home in 24 years. His mother died soon after he emigrated and his father died three years ago. The family circle was further broken when two brothers were killed in the war.

Mr. Lenz, who besides being projectionist at the local Roxy Theatre, also operates an electrical contracting business of his own, will have no difficulty in entering his homeland as he does not have to pass through the Russian occupied zone on his trip. He sailed from New York City last Wednesday aboard the Queen Elizabeth. He will be returning to town the end of October, and after Austria he intends to visit Switzerland and France, as well as spending a few days with relatives in New York City on his home trip.
