### Another New Teacher For Growing Public School Enrolment

Increasing enrolment in the twopublic schools has led to engaging another full-time teacher at Wrigglesworth school, and the probability that another teacher will have to be added at Chapel Street school befor the end of this term.

Last week Mrs. Ann Gwizdala joined the Wrigglesworth staff, to teach a combined Grade 5 and 7 class which is used in the new addition.

The 4-room addition, completed in December if now completely filled, while Chapel School is also taxed to capacity for accommodation.

Coming of Mrs. Gwizdala to the school makes four new teachers engaged this school year, two in September and two in. danuary. Ten teachers are now employed at each school.
