## Local Delegates Attend Weston Jehovah Assembly

Local delegates from the Georgetown congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses enjoyed the three-day assembly at Weston, April 23-24.

On Friday, the program had as its theme "Training for the Ministerial Work" (Eph. 4:12). This showed Christians must be active ministers to gain God's approval and live. It further suggested methods which can be used in helping people come to a greater understanding and appreciation of the Bible.

On Saturday, 23 persons were baptized. These ministers thereby signified their desire to accept the responsibility of preaching God's Word whenever possible. At a later session, a film entitled "The New World Society in Action" was shown to an audience of 350 people, who filled

the hall to overflowing. The film depicted how millions of publications are printed and made in the nine-storey factory in Brooklyn, New York; and the 500 people who are voluntary workers there — all in the interests of bible education. Scenes of assemblies in South Africa, Germany, England and an outstanding assembly of 20,000 natives in Central Africa were also shown. It was pointed out that the Watchtower magazine has increased from a circulation of 6,000 copies per issue to 2,000,000 copies; and the witnesses are increasing at the rate of one every 11 minutes. They are preaching in 150 countries, under the supervision of 80 branch offices.

The main talk of the assembly — "Why a New World is Possible" was given on Sunday afternoon by C. E. Hepworth, district minister, to 850 people. The speaker showed that in as much as Christendom had rejected God's King, a new world society would be formed. Mr. Hepworth also pointed to the many scriptures that identify this new world society and noted that this society operates to the amazement of the world — free from racial and national strife, completely at unity, a further evidence as pointed to by the scriptures of the new world society. The speaker also reminded his listeners that the preaching methods of this new world society, while unique by today's standards, are exactly the same as used in the apostles' days.

Mr. Hepworth cited from Ezekiel chapter 9, concerning the impending doom facing this world, and also from Isaiah 65 and other scriptures pointing to the conditions to be expected in God's Kingdom.

The speaker emphasized the necessity of preparing NOW to live in that new world arrangement. Bible study and living by its standards will ensure the individual of gaining everlasting life in God's righteous new world.

A cafeteria arrangement was provided for all the delegates attending this assembly, and a total of 1800 meals were served during the three day period.

The Sunday sessions concluded with all present being invited to attend the 1965 assemblies in New York, Chicago, Dallas, Los Angeles and Vancouver, as well as at London, England, Paris, Rome, Germany and Sweden.

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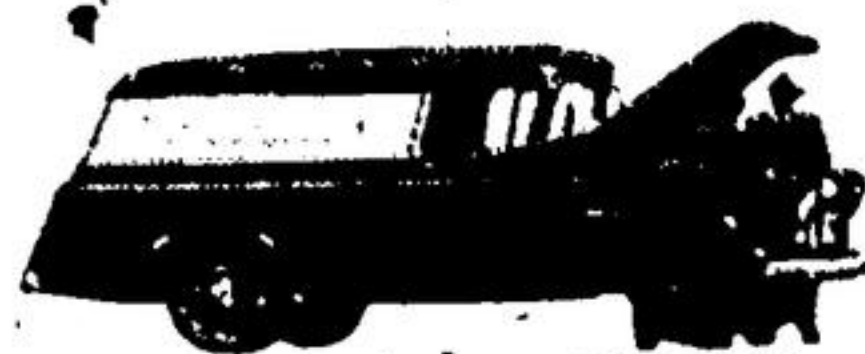
