

#### **Prep School Planting** Totals 275,000 Trees

Something has been added to the program of reforestation begun at Norval by the Prep School of Upper Canada College in 1939. Each spring. after the tree planting is' finished, there is a picnic at the 500-acre farm on the banks of the Credit River, a bit of congratulation on the achievements to date, and some planning for

the years to come. Recently Alan G. A. Stephen, headmaster of the school, was host to 50 or so sight members, parents of pupils, and for the first time, to members of the Credit Valley Conservation Authwrity.
