Holstein Breeders Hear About Ketosis Disease

Dr. Jim Henderson of the Ontario Veterinary College, Guelph, was the chief speaker at the combined Holstein Twilight and 4-H Dairy Calf Club members' meeting held at the Hays Sales Arena recently. Well over 200 were in attendance to hear Dr. Henderson deal with Ketosis or Acetonemia.

In the majority of cases, stated Dr. Henderson, Ketosis is a secondary condition and associated with nutritional imbalance, physical condi-

tion which results in the burning of body fat thus creating ketones in the blood stream. "At one time," added Dr. Henderson "I thought Ketosis or Acetonemia was associated with cobalt deficiency - this was true in some five or six herds we had under treatment - however, we soon came across other herds where cobalt deficiency was not the primary contributing factor to Ketosis."

Recent work would indicate, according to Dr. Henderson, that some of our mineral mixtures are too high in fluorine, and maybe in some herds a contributing cause to Ketosis. Dr. Henderson dealt with this highly technical disease in a most interesting,

practical manner, which held the attention of his audience throughout. He was frank to admit that there is much about the disease of Ketosis or Acetonemia which is still unknown to the veterinarian profession. Consequently treatment which gives results in the case of one cow or herd, does not necessarily prove satisfactory in other herds or cows.

George Pellitterio, president of the Halton Holstein Club, and Ross Austin, president of the 4-H Holstein Calf Club, were the joint chairmen of the evening's programme, which also included a demonstration on "Dairy Type", by Bruce Stone of the Animal Husbandry Dept. at the OAC and a

judging competition. In the latter, D. S. Dunton, Peel Holstein breeder, and Bruce Stone, were the official judges. The prize winners were - ladies, Miss Alfred Wilson; Men, Don Peer; club members, Neil Moffat and Harvey Pell.

—Brampton Salvation Army group is conducting a fund campaign and hopes to raise \$1,000 in Georgetown. Capt.
