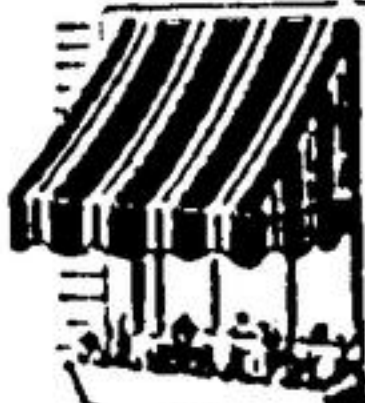

**WHAT COUNCIL DID**

**Seek Better Drainage For Cloverdale Area**

Council wrote Central Mortgage & Housing about installing storm sewers in Cloverdale Heights where surface drainage is coming down onto Churchill Crescent. The town refuses to take over ownership of roads in the subdivision until drainage problems are completely under control.

A local contractor, who is making repairs to the boiler in the municipal building has recommended that a new boiler be installed and the location moved upstairs out of the damp basement. The property committee will consider this.

Joe Frank interviewed council about a bill for back taxes which he has received. He will produce a certificate that the taxes were paid to date at the time he bought, he said, and council told him to get in touch with the town clerk and the matter could be cleared up.

Anthony Seynuck, president of Anthony Gas and Explorations Ltd. presented brochures about his company to council and again asked council to pass a by-law giving him a franchise to sell natural gas in Georgetown.

Mr. Seynuck said that the company to which Georgetown is already considering giving such a franchise has no gas of their own, while he has supplies available on the spot.

Council will consult the town solicitor and ask for his opinion of the question.

**RUBY LAIRD TELLS OF MISSION HOSPITAL**
