In the finals at Huttonville Park he defeated six other contestants to win the honour. The week before 14 contestants vied for positions in the finals, eight of whom were chosen. They were Bob McGonigle and Roy Renwick, Brampton; Ike Mitchell, Dan Castrucci, Tim McQueston and Jim McHenry, Toronto; Vic Pasowisty, of Winnipeg; and Mervin McPherson, of Waldemar. Jim McHenry withdrew from the finals, leaving only seven eligible.

Following Vic came Roy Renwick, Brampton's "flying fiddler" and Dan Castrucci. Among the three judges to make the decision was Ned Langry, from Nova Scotia, a famous fiddler himself.

Last week at the Canadian Open, Roy Renwick came second, beaten only by "Sleepy" Marlin of Louisville, Ky. This year Roy will not have the chance to compete as only the winners of each division will attend. Mas-

ter of ceremonies was Vince Mountford of Brampton who also conducted a sing-song. The provincial champion square dance group gave a demonstration while the judges were reaching their decision.

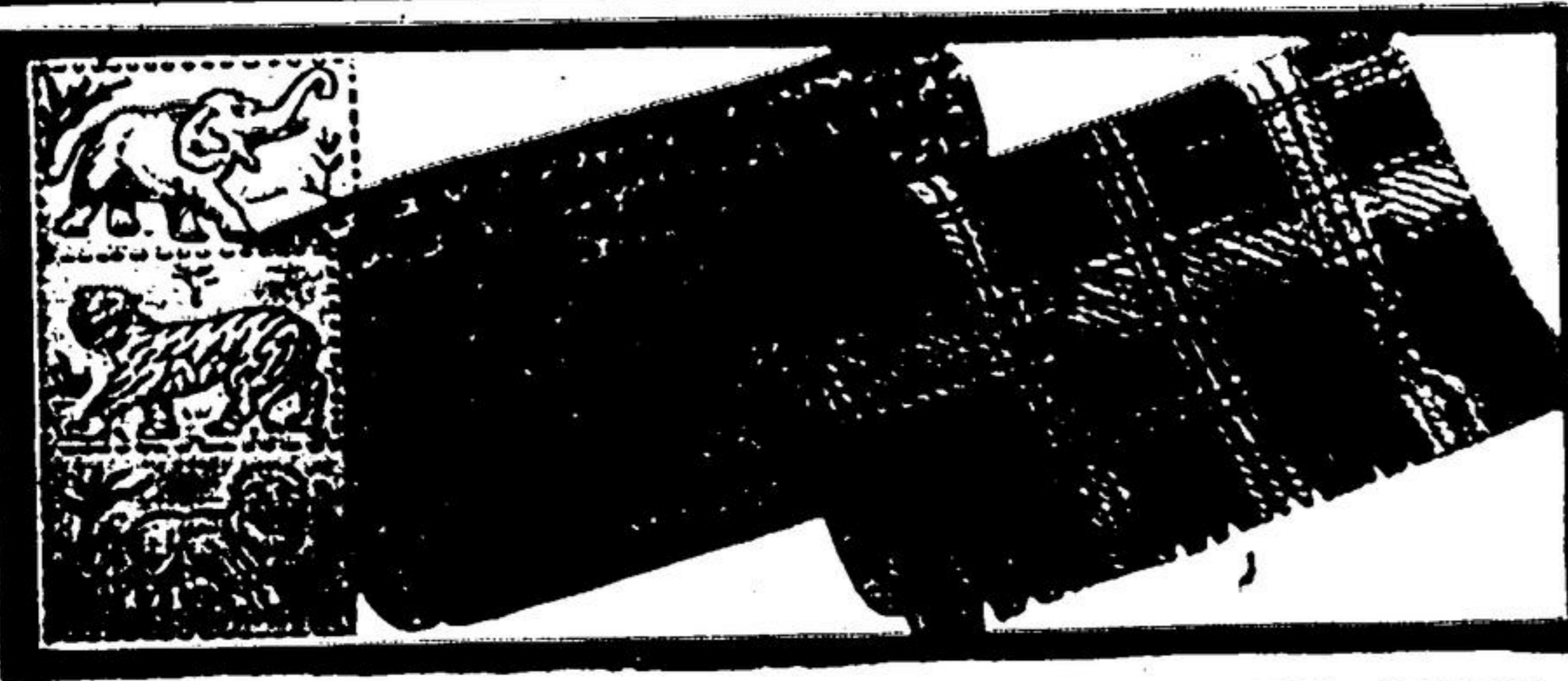

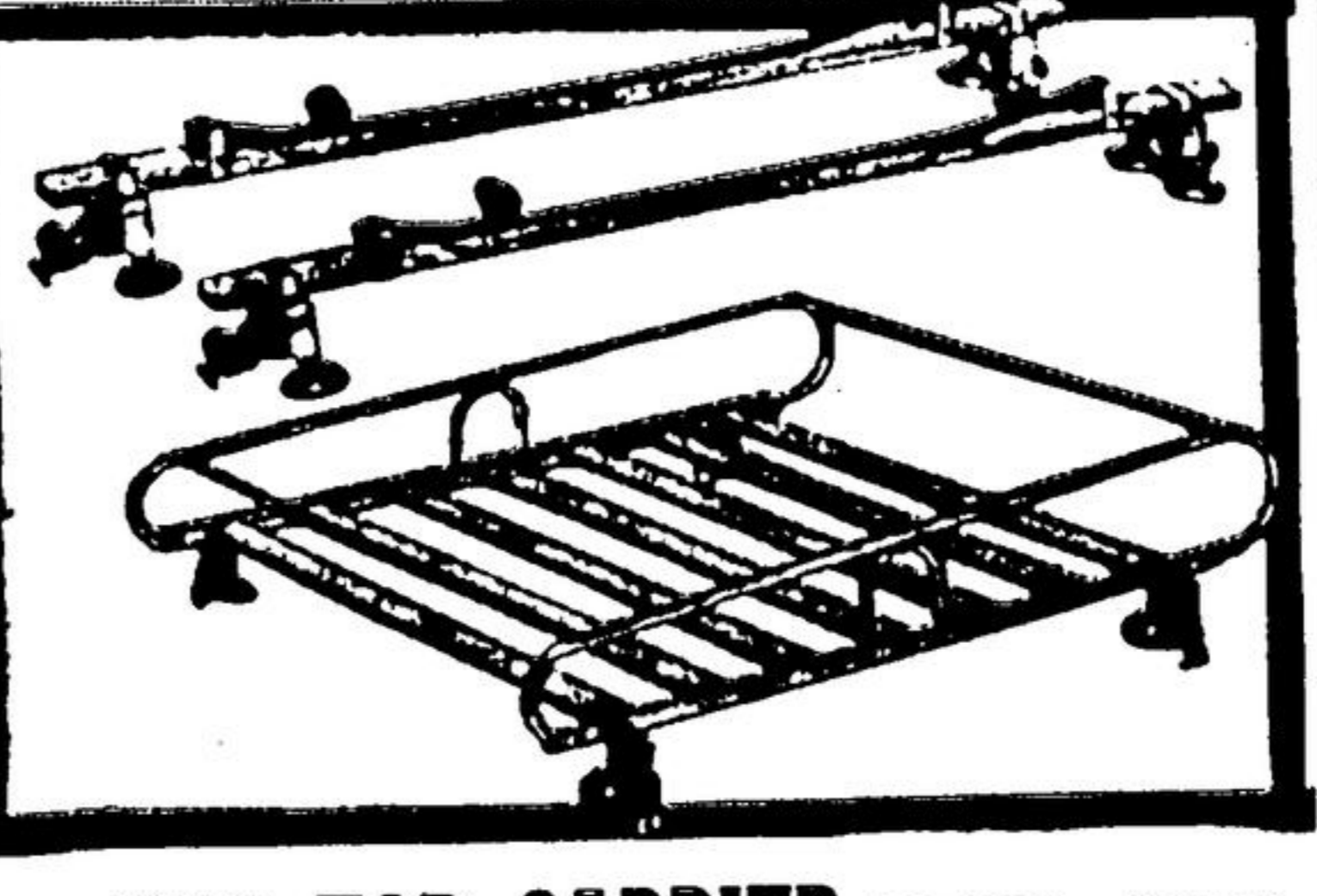
