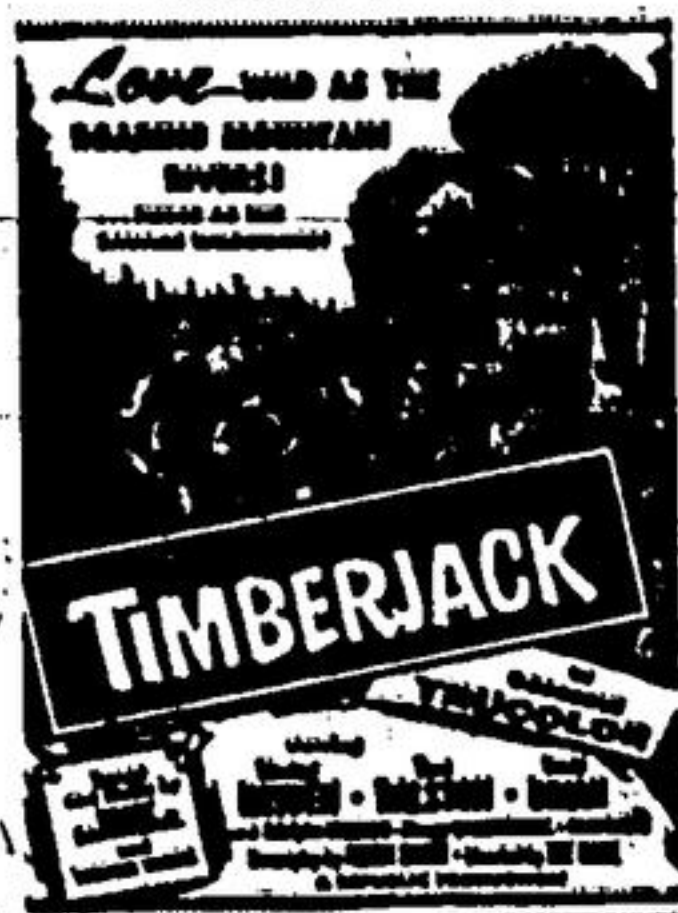

PUBLIC NOTICE

IN ACCORDANCE WITH BUILDING BY-LAW 489 AND AMENDMENTS, IT IS NECESSARY THAT A BUILDING PERMIT BE OBTAINED PRIOR TO COMMENCING THE FOLLOWING WORK

- The erection, alteration, repair, demolition, or moving of any or part of any building, or accessory building;
- The construction of cesspools, septic tanks, or dry wells;
- The erection of fences within 30 feet of the street boundary;
- Construction, demolition or repair of any nature;

APPLICATION FORMS for Building Permits may be obtained at the Municipal Office. Each application must be accompanied by suitable plans, specifications and a lot plan showing the location of the proposed work.

The Building Permit cards issued must be placed in a location clearly visible from the street and as close to the proposed work as possible.

The Building Inspector may be consulted at the Municipal Offices or by telephone.
