SMITH & STONE IS FEATURED ON TV

A television show on CBC News Magazine Sunday featured a commentary on the plastic industry to which the local Smith and Stone plant contributed.

News cameramen from the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation had earlier spent a day in Georgetown filming scenes in the new plastics plant on Victoria Street.

Some 200 feet of film was shot here, but only a small fraction was used on the TV show which also had shots of a bakelite plant in Belleville, a polyethylene plant in Edmonton and the Eastman butyrate factory. These factories produce basic raw materials used in products manufactured in Georgetown.

The program was seen on Channel 9, Toronto at 7:30 p.m.

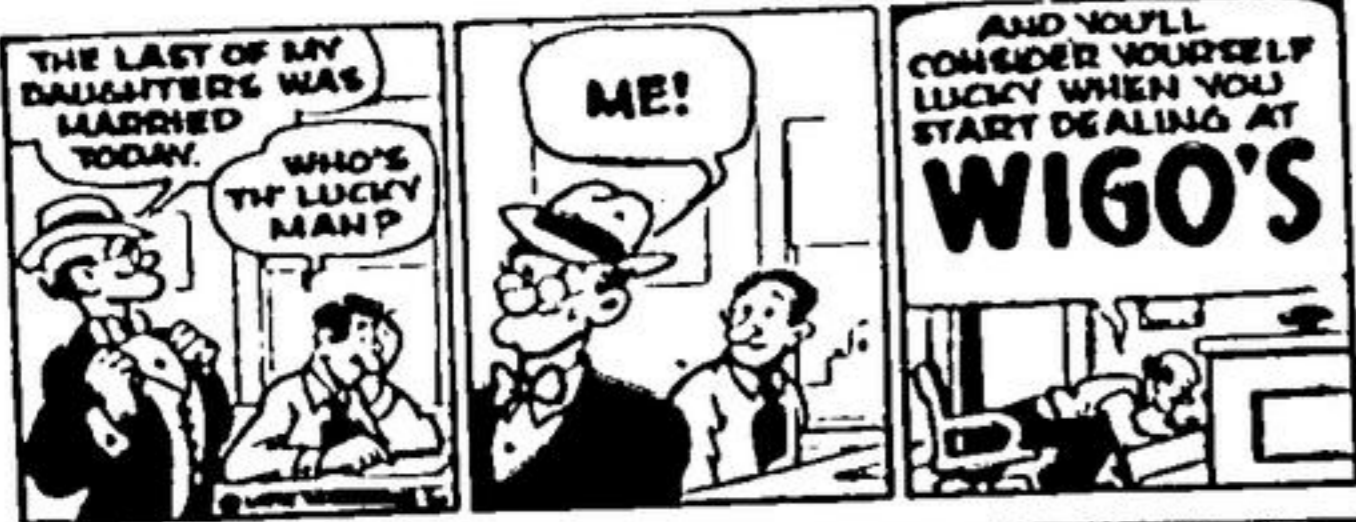
