He was a life member of the Peel Jersey Club and a member, since its beginning, of the Halton Jersey Club in which he took an active part until he had to give it up two years ago on account of his health. Sixty years ago Mr. Ruddell was a member of the Georgetown Fair Board. He was an active member of the Ashgrove United Church.

Mr. and Mrs. Ruddell were very fortunate that they celebrated their 55th wedding anniversary last June. All their family, who survive him, were with them. They are Frank, Jessie (Mrs. A. N. Stark), Annie (Mrs. C. Birch), Louise (Mrs. M. Alexander), John, Fred and Newton. Mrs. Ruddell was the former Louisa Maria Hardy.

Mr. Ruddell was the last member of his family of four brothers and two sisters. He left seventeen grandchildren and two great grandchildren.
