ABOUT NEW ZEALAND**

Vernon Rout, geography teacher at  
Brampton district high school, told  
of his native New Zealand when  
he spoke to members of Terra Cotta  
Farmers club at their October meet-  
ing at the home of Mr. and Mrs. F. L.  
Thompson.

He told about the Maori race, and  
listeners were impressed by their an-  
cient customs and love of warfare.  
Mr. Rout's address was given with a  
great deal of zest and contained many  
humorous incidents of his experi-  
ence as a teacher in that country. Of  
interest is the fact that all New Zeal-  
and teachers must teach three years  
in rural districts after leaving teach-  
er's colleges before moving to a town  
or city, thus ensuring all parts of the  
country the benefit of young, vigor-  
ous teachers.
