New Plastic Panelling  
Produced by Fiberglas

W. E. Phillips, president, Fiberglas Canada Limited, today announced the completion of a manufacturing arrangement with the Alsynite Company of America under which Fiberglas will utilize Alsynite processes to manufacture translucent structural panelling of Fiberglas reinforced plastic.

Under the trade name of Fiberglas Alsynite, the panelling will be in production by October 15 at the new \$250,000 addition to the Fiberglas plant at Guelph, and will be available to the public through lumber and building supply dealers early in November.

The new one-storey building will provide 10,000 square feet of floor space and will be devoted entirely to the manufacture of the structural panelling. Construction of the building is the third company expansion in Guelph since the original \$2,000,000 textile plant was built in 1952.

A feature of the new building will be the installation of Fiberglas Alsynite translucent structural panels in the walls instead of using regular glass windows. These panels eliminate glare and transmit a diffused light throughout the building.

Lightweight, shatterproof and weatherproof, either flat or corrugated, Fiberglas Alsynite translucent panelling is easy to saw and nail and can be installed as easily as plywood. It is available in a variety of decorator colours.

The panelling is an excellent "do-it-yourself" material for the amateur builder. Easy to handle, it can be installed with professional results as partitions, decorative panelling, permanent shower walls, sliding cupboard doors, skylights and windows.

Unbreakable and non-corroding, Fiberglas Alsynite panelling's translucent qualities are best illustrated when the material is used for windows, awnings, roofs, sidewalls and carports while its steel like strength and attractive appearance is emphasized in its use as office enclosures, display cases and for the front of commercial buildings.

In institutional and commercial structures, the panelling provides excellent indirect lighting when fluorescent bulbs are mounted behind valances, doors or complete sidewall panels.
