The following are extracts from a letter from Mr. I. B. Bruce, President of the International Association of Police Chiefs, to Commissioner E. V. McNeil of the Ontario Provincial Police.

"DEVIL TAKES US" won the 1952 David S. Beyer Memorial Award, presented by the Liberty Mutual Insurance Company for the best theatrical motion picture on traffic safety produced in that year. It also received documentary nominations from the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences and was chosen by the National Committee on Films for safety as one of the outstanding accident prevention films produced in 1952.
