#### Mothering Sunday Marked by Anglicans

At the conclusion of the service, each child was given a golden coloured daffodil as a present for their mother. The flowers were arranged and obtained by the Ladies Parish Guild. Later in the day a family supper was convened under the leadership of the same group.
