The first pleblacite ever held under the international trusteeship system is currently underway in Togoland under British Administration, a small United Nations trust territory in West Africa. This plebiscite follows a decision of the United Kingdom to grant independence to the neighboring colony of the Gold Coast in conjunction with which British Togoland has been administered for the past 40 years. The Togolese are being asked to state whether they wish to join an independent Gold Coast, or continue under UN trusteeship. The holding of the plebiscite was approved by the Tenth General Assembly and is being conducted under the supervision of a UN Plebiscite Commissioner, assisted by an international corps of observers.
