Three-School Registrations Back to School on Tuesday

Public schools reopen in Georgetown next Tuesday, September 4. For the first time in the town's history there will be three full public schools, but until construction is completed on the new Harrison School, a staggered system will combine two schools in one. This will be in effect at least until the end of the year.

Chapel Street School under the principal Val Stein, will follow the usual school hours this year, 9 to 12 and 1 to 4.

Wrigglesworth School under principal William Kinrade, will be conducted from 8 a.m. to 12 noon in September. Harrison School under Principal Harold Henry, using the same building, meets from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. in September. The two schools will alternate these schedules monthly.

As there are many pupils who will be attending a different school than last year, the public school board has decided to insert a full list of pupils in this Herald issue. Each pupil can find his school, room and teacher by checking the lists in this edition.

There will be pupils, of course, who have moved to town during the summer. These, or any whose names were missed by error in compiling the lists. These should register at their nearest school on Tuesday. At Chapel Street, newcomers should register with the principal at 9 a.m. At the other two schools, they can come any time during the day, where a teacher will be on duty to register them.

Children whose names appear in the school lists should register as follows:

At Chapel Street and Wrigglesworth schools at 10.00 a.m.

At Harrison School, (in the Wrigglesworth school building)

at 2 p.m.
School will be in session for only one hour in each case on opening day, with the regular schedule starting on Wednesday.
