BRITISH MG Sports Car Breaks 63 Speed Records



KEN MILES OF LOS ANGELES, California and Johnny Lockett of Claverdon, Warwick, England, (left to right) beside the streamlined MG sports car which they co-piloted to 16 new International and 48 American Class F records on the 10 mile circular course laid out on the Salt Flats at Bonneville, Utah. The little 1489 CC, 4 cylinder car performed brilliantly for 12 straight hours covering 1700.57 miles at an average of 141.71 MPH for the run. This includes stops for mechanical check up and refueling. Gasoline performance averaged better than 25 miles per gallon. The chassis of the MG is basically standard, as are suspension, wheels, brakes and steering. The engine is not supercharged.
