**The Board of Parks Management...**

In asking you to support the debenture issue with your vote next Monday, points out this pertinent information:

- The arena will be usable as a community centre 12 months in the year. Now it is usable for only ice events.
- Artificial ice was installed and paid off in 9 years, through profits and the 1 mill grant to which the parks board is entitled each year.
- This \$111,000 debenture is planned to be paid off in the same way... In 1957, the grant will amount to \$8630. Debenture payments will be \$11,058.44 annually... so our operation must show profit of \$2428 per year.
- In 1955-56 we earned \$3500 over and above expenses. Assuming we can earn the same profit in future years, the parks board is well able to meet all obligations without further assistance from the town.
- Assuming a 2 million dollar increase in assessment, equal to the 1956 increase, the 1 mill grant alone will be sufficient to retire the debenture payments.

REMEMBER, the arena cannot continue to operate unless necessary repairs are made... It's your job to decide... and we hope a large majority will say "Yes."

**BLUEPRINT FOR A CITY DELREX SALES FILM**

Members of the Chamber of Commerce viewed a 15-minute coloured movie last Tuesday, prepared by Delrex Developments for showing to prospects interested in locating in the subdivision's industrial area.

The movie starts with scenes in a busy city, then switches to the Georgetown highway approach and farm fields in process of being converted into future residential, industrial and commercial sites.

Emphasis is heavy in the film on decentralization and the advantages of living in rural surroundings, yet still close to larger centres. Families are shown walking in the "green belt" areas reserved for the country living which is one of Delrex's selling points.

There are scenes of Delrex officials in conference with council, engineers and architects. Other scenes show Smith & Stone employees leaving the plant after a day's work, a scale model of Delrex as it will look when completed, and some of the homes already built in the subdivision. The film is titled "Blueprint for a City."
