

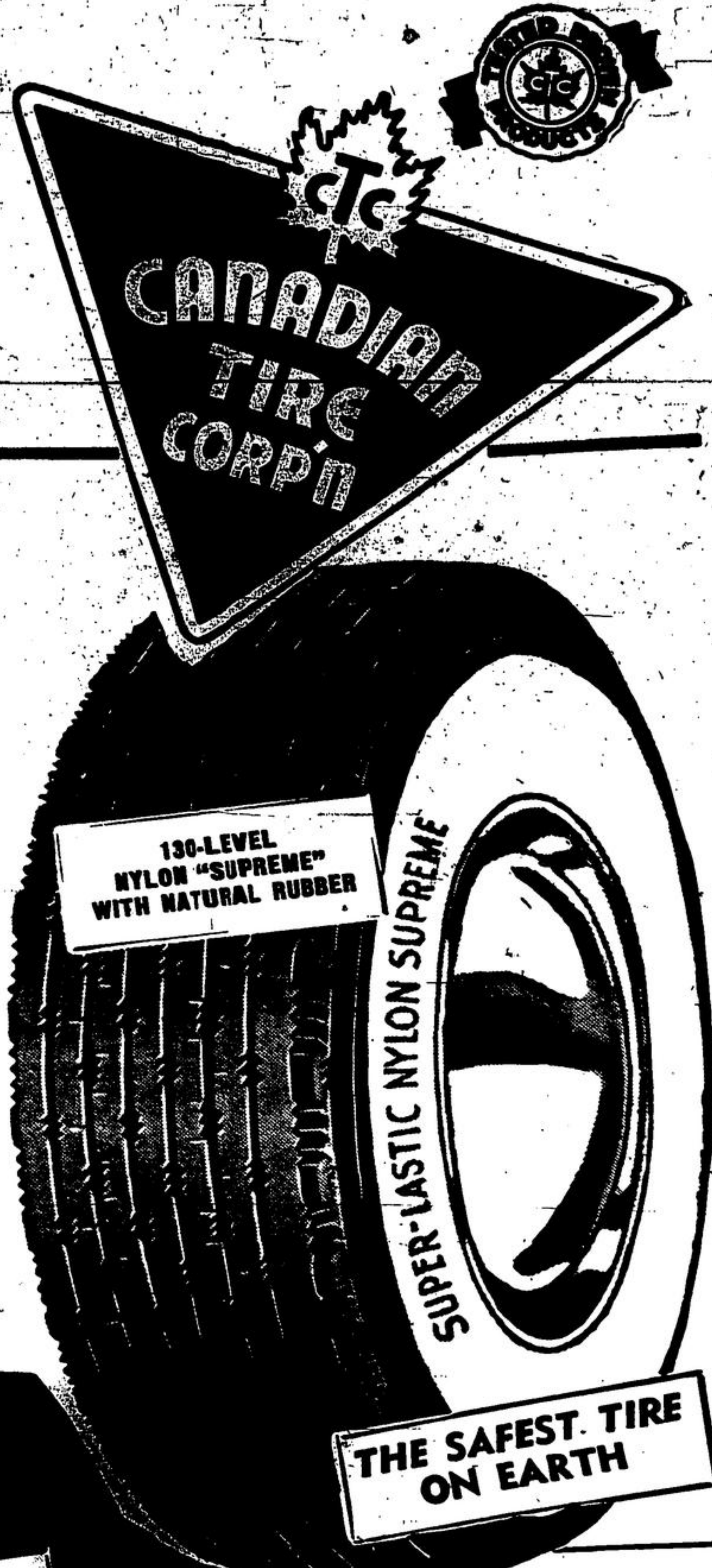

Will Ask Shoppers of Store Hour Preference

A survey, designed to find opinion of the general public on local shopping hours, will be undertaken by Georgetown Chamber of Commerce.

The survey was decided upon at a Chamber of Commerce meeting last week, and will be conducted by means of a questionnaire. Distribution has been arranged thru the hydro commission which has agreed to distribute the questionnaire with monthly billings and to receive replies when people are making their bill payments.

Results will be available for study by merchants who at present are operating on two different plans, with grocers, butchers, barbers and beauticians closing Mondays and open all day Thursdays, and other stores observing a Thursday half-holiday.
