
Veteran Of First War
Thomas Grieve Dies
A charter member of Branch 120, Canadian Legion, Thomas Forsythe Grieve, 84, died early Friday morning in Sunnybrook Hospital, Toronto. He had been rushed there the previous Tuesday after suffering a severe heart seizure at his home, 25 Queen St. He had been a Georgetown resident for 35 years, first working at the old Provincial "lumber mill" and later at Allison Paper until ill health forced him to quit his job. Mr. Grieve later operated a taxi business and recently held the post of bailiff. **if**
He was born on an Erasmus Township farm near Beckwith, son of the late William and Jessie Rutherford Grieve. Enlisting in the first world war with the 93rd Battalion in Guelph, he went overseas with the Black Watch, was wounded in action in France on August 4th, 1916, and after his recovery spent the balance of the war years in Britain with the forestry corps. **if**
In 1917 he married L. Blanche Bounds of London, England, who was a nurse in the army hospital where he spent his convalescence. They returned to Canada after the war, lived for a time on the farm before coming to Georgetown. **if**
Mr. Grieve was one of the men instrumental in forming the local Legion branch. He was present at the inaugural meeting on March 14th, 1928, became a charter member and was the first sergeant-at-arms. He later served in executive positions in that organization. At one time he was a member of the volunteer fire department, and held the post of fire truck driver. **if**
Surviving are his wife, a daughter Audrey, son Alva and five grandchildren, and one sister, Mrs. Henry Mann, Galt. **if**
