Russ had an 81 the first day to advance to the semi-finals, but his 79 the second day didn't give him a low enough score to reach the finals.

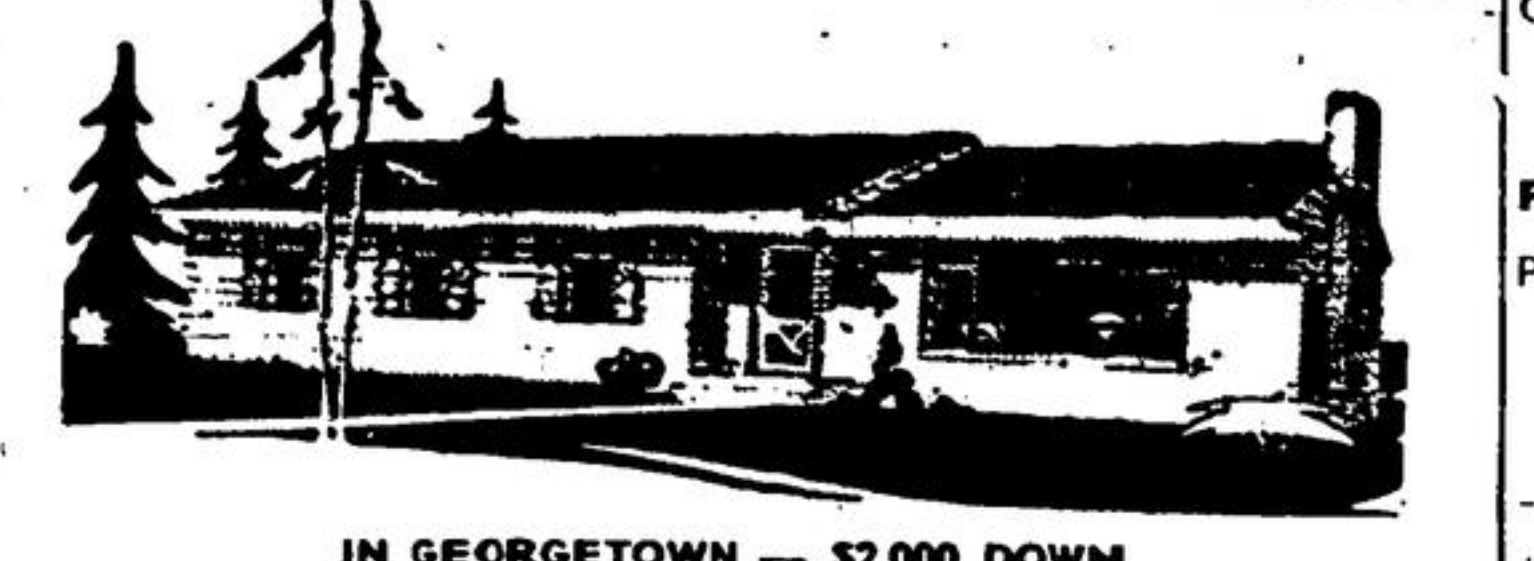
