TUMBLER - Rotates 45 rpm. Enamelled rust-resistant sheet steel welded construction with 3 vanes. Perforations only at back end of drum for air circulation.

INSULATION - Moving air stream keeps cabinet cool. In addition, there is a seal around back of drum against

bulkhead and around drum opening against cabinet front. MOTOR - 1/2 h.p. motor, oiled for life, has built-in, self-restoring circurit breaker for motor protection, built-in heat switch which turns off heating unit when motor stops.

LINT SCREEN - Built-in lint screen conveniently located on top of dryer.
