Relegate Victoria Crank Phones to History Niche

"Victoria's crank telephones are on their way out," L. G. Denby, manager for this territory, announced this week. Early next year the present magneto telephone system will be replaced by a "common battery" system, similar to that now in use in Snelgrove and Huttonville.
With the new system, telephone users will merely take the receiver off the hook to signal an operator. Cranking will be eliminated. Electricity to ring the called telephone, transmit the voice, and signal the operator will come from a control battery system, instead of from cells in each telephone set.
Bell Telephone men will install the common battery type of telephone sets on subscribers premises, starting almost immediately. The crank sets will be removed after the new system is in service.
Another important phase of the improvement program now underway is the rebuilding of the wire and cable system serving the Victoria area. This involves burying 17,000 feet of cable, stringing more than 16,000 feet of aerial cable and 8 miles of wire, and erecting nearly 100 poles.
When the new system goes into service all Victoria telephone numbers will be changed. However, the new numbers will be announced in advance.
Another advantage to come at the same time as the change to the new system, is a reduction in the number of parties on telephone lines.
"This improvement will be made possible by a rearrangement of facilities and the use of additional equipment," Mr. Denby explained.
Later next year, a group of subscribers in the Victoria exchange area will begin to get dial service through the Georgetown exchange. The section between No. 22 and No. 32 Sideroads in the Terra Cotta area, will be transferred from the Victoria exchange area to the Georgetown area.

DOES THE BODY EVER CORRECT ITSELF?
