## FOUR TEAM LEAGUE INDUSTRIAL HOCKEY

The 1957-58 industrial hockey executive was retained Thursday night when the league held its election of officers at the arena. George Barber is again president and Carl Petterson is secretary-treasurer.

The league will again consist of just four teams as was the case last season but that's about all that survived the shuffle as the league underwent a major facelifting which resulted in the withdrawal of Provincial and Smith & Stone from the loop.

Even last year's two remaining entrants, Combines and Toronto, were affected by the change. The Combines will be in the campaign this year under the name of their sponsors, Halton Homes and Toronto Metros are now the Barlocks. Junior Beaumont, Ron Breen, Mike Lorusso and George Barber will handle the officiating in a double header exhibition at the arena Sunday afternoon. Halton Homes showed no loss of scoring power during the off season and tumbled Co-Op handily, 11 to 7 the final score. Barlocks mean while had trouble with the other new entry, Glen Williams, in the second game and emerged with only a one goal margin in their 7-6 win.

The 1958-59 season gets underway this Sunday when Halton Homes takes on Barlocks, and Co-Op clash with the Glen. Games start at 2 and 2.30.
