WATER SAFETY COUNCIL
URGES BOATING CAUTION
Friday, May 1st marks the opening of another fishing season which will bring many a thrill to sportsmen. The local water safety council urges parents at this time to caution their children on a few points before setting out on a fishing trip. Parents should always know where their children are going, and that they are accompanied by a responsible companion, the council urges.

All occupants of boats are reminded to abide by the Dept. of Transport ruling on boat handling. As a safety measure, the council emphasizes two main points, not to overload and to be sure all non swimming occupants are wearing government-approved life jackets. Boating was the number one cause of drowning last year in Canada, due mainly to poor handling. Fifty five lives were lost through accidents which could have been prevented. Let's all do
