### Historical Trip for Wrigglesworth Grade 7

At seven o'clock last Thursday morning, the long and eagerly awaited hour finally arrived. The bus came to the school and the whole class of Grade Seven, Howard Wrigglesworth School, piled in.

After chatting loudly above the roar of the motor, we stopped first at the Hamilton Rock Gardens, which are commonly called. They are really the Royal Botanical Gardens. They are just lovely and those who had cameras took many pictures. In these gardens there are artificially created ponds, with water lilies and other water plants growing in them. Next came Stoney Creek and its high monument erected and unveiled by Queen Mary in 1918. At Stoney Creek there is also a museum showing articles of furniture and clothing from private collections, used in the time of the war of 1812. Not being too disappointed at not climbing the stone monument, we went on to the locks on the Welland Canal at Thorold. You'd be amazed at the size of the boats that go through the locks.

After a short ride in the bus, we stopped this time at Queenston Heights Park. Most of us being very hungry, we rushed for the lunch counter. When finished eating, those who chose to do so, climbed Brock's Monument. This building is different from the one at Stoney Creek. It is 285 feet high and has 135 steps in it. After the climb, we were all glad to settle down in the comfortable bus seats.

Fort George came next, and what a lovely well-kept place it is. Here there were in all ten (I think) points of interest. Here too there are museums showing clothing and furniture of the early 1800's.

The Adam Beck Generating Station No. 2, is a wonderful building. We jammed ourselves into an elevator and went down over two hundred feet, then through a tunnel and came out at the bottom of the cliff. It's a beautiful building and has underground tunnels dug out of solid rock.

After visiting the station, we went to the Falls themselves. Oh, they're magnificent. The Canadian Horseshoe Falls and the American Falls are really gorgeous. Those who wished, crossed the Rainbow Bridge on foot and shopped around in Niagara Falls, N.Y. The pupils who stayed in Canada were allowed on their own. When we came back to Canada, we shopped then too, but this time in Niagara Falls, Canada.

In think everyone enjoyed the trip and even the stop for supper in Burlington. I imagine, though, everyone of us was glad to get home and relate the story to the family.

I hope Mr. Pinkerton, our class teacher, and Mr. Kinrade, our school principal, enjoyed the trip as much as the class did.
