### WHAT COUNCIL DID

## Storm Sewer, Surfacing For Delrex Boulevard

Delrex Blvd. joined other Delrex roads which will be surfaced this summer, when a decision was made at the June 29th council meeting to call tenders for grading ditches and applying prime and chip to the travelled portion of the road. At the same time, a decision was made to instal a \$5,000 storm sewer at the Rexway - Delrex corner to overcome drainage troubles in the area.

A few weeks ago a \$32,082 tender was awarded Peel Construction Co. for surfacing a number of Delrex roads. Later, Rexway Drive was added to the list and the inclusion of Delrex means that all roads in the subdivision which have been taken over by the town will soon be surfaced.

Before the boulevard vote was taken, Cr. Ern Hyde asked that portions of the original agreement between Delrex Developments and the town be read, as he believed there were stipulations in the agreement covering drainage.

Only reference in the agreement was to the land firm providing "services" which Cr. John Elliott said he would interpret as meaning drainage.

"We thought that in the Swanek case too" said Mayor Armstrong, referring to a storm sewer in that subdivision which led to court action which is still pending. "Our present subdivision bylaw includes drainage but it wasn't in force when Delrex came to town."

Cr. Hyde said he thought the drainage question should be decided before any storm sewer work is proceeded with in Delrex.

\$150,000 has been mentioned as the cost of sewers. We're going to be asked to take over other roads and that \$150,000 will be a lot more as time goes on" he said.

Cr. Harrison said that the company has installed some storm sewers on their own, as well as sidewalks which weren't included in the company's obligation to the town.

"Don't confuse the issue with sidewalks," replied Cr. Hyde. "Par chasers of the houses paid for them. What I contend is that Del rex is not properly drained and that the company should be instructed to do so."

It had never been implied at any time, Cr. Hyde continued, that the town would be faced with installing storm sewers.

"At the time we made the agreement we weren't paying much attention to storm sewers" said the mayor.

With Cr. Hyde asking a week's delay so the engineer and solicitor could check the agreement to see if storm sewers were implied in it, Cr. McGilvray, whose motion it was to install them said the road committee had checked thoroughly

into the matter and he could see no reason for further delay.

"I'm surprised to hear you say you haven't read up on the agreement" said Cr. Harrison to Cr. Hyde.

"I haven't read the bible through either, but I pick out what I want from it" replied the councillor.

Cr. John Gunn interjected at this point that committees are set up to deal with matters in their jurisdiction, and he is getting tired of having matters set over for a week.

Cr. Hyde, replied that he is not on the road committee and he has no right to speak at their meetings if he does not attend them, but he has a right to discuss a report when it is made at council.

Road chairman Gray spoke at some length about road work. When he took over the department a few years ago town roads were "a disgrace" he said and he has tried constantly to improve them. This year \$40,000 has been budgeted for Delrex surfacing and so far council has got nowhere with the work.

"We had a little trouble in one place and decided that this \$5,000 would take care of it," he said. "We are getting considerable taxes from Delrex and they have a right to decent roads. We're losing the best part of the year if we don't get at them."

Reeve Sargent said he could share some of Cr. Hyde's views and that the word "services" in the agreement would indicate to him that storm sewers were implied.

"However, we accepted the roads on the recommendation of the engineer of that day, and by accepting them we let the company out of any obligation," he said.

Cr. Anne Currie said there are already two 21" sewers in the area and she assumes the subdivider thought that was adequate for the drainage.

"I'll be like the other councillors and solicit Delrex votes by saying I want them to have storm sewers - but I'll go farther and say I don't want those taxpayers to pay for them" was Cr. Hyde's parting shot.

Cr. Elliott, who sides with Cr. Hyde in the debate, said he could not vote for the storm sewers as he feels they are subdivider's responsibility.

### CONTINUES SERMON SERIES ON BAPTIST BELIEFS

Continuing a series of Baptist beliefs in connection with the Baptist jubilee Advance recognizing the 150th anniversary of organized Baptist work on the continent, Rev. Lloyd Whan, minister of 1st Baptist Church based his sermon Sunday on the "priesthood of the believer."

"The Bible plainly sets forth this great doctrine. Every Christian is his own priest in that he needs no one else to act as priest for him to stand between him and the end" stated Mr. Whan. "We do not need someone on earth now to petition to God in our stead and every Christian can intercede with God for himself."

"He can approach God directly through Christ and Christ alone has the authority to forgive sins," he said. "The Apostle John wrote of Jesus Christ that 'He made us kings and priests until God.'" the Apostle Peter wrote to early believers "Ye are a royal priesthood." the Apostle Paul wrote "There is one mediator between God and men, the man Jesus Christ."

"The Christian priesthood forms a brotherhood of all Christians and not a religious rule of priests or hierarchy. The New Testament churches did not set apart any special persons as priests and Baptists follow thier example. The gift and knowledge of God come directly to each individual Christian and no third party is necessary."

"Because each person can approach God for himself no man can act for another in spiritual matters. A minister can not do for members of his church, what God expects them to do for themselves. The person who has not become a follower of Christ may go to God directly in prayer and declare his desire to follow Christ."
