

Agricultural Extension Branch Moved To New Location

The Extension Branch of the Ontario Department of Agriculture for Halton County has re-located the Milton Office on December 1st, to the Centre Building, on Main St., Milton. In addition to the present staff of the Agricultural Representative Service, Mr. Earl F. Muir, Fruit and Vegetable Extension Specialist, will be located in the Milton office. The Fruit and Vegetable Extension Service was formerly located in Oakville. The move will allow for closer co-ordination of services with the Extension Branch in Halton County. The Official Opening of the new Agricultural office will be made on Wednesday, January 6th. There will be an opportunity to view the new location at an Open House, planned for Wednesday, January 6th, from 3:00 to 5:00 p.m., and from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. The Extension Branch personnel attached to the Milton office includes: Miss M. Downs, secretary; E. F. Muir, Fruit & Vegetable Specialist; D. E. Jackson, Assistant Agricultural Representative; and J. A. Francis, Agricultural Representative. In addition to the regular staff, Miss Frances Lampman, of the Home Economics Service and Mr. W. Ross Milne, Agricultural Engineering Specialist, will be working out of the Milton office on a part time basis, in addition to their duties in other counties.

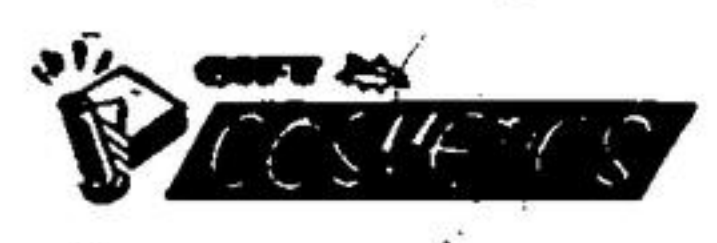
Killarney Farmer Went To Manitoba in 1913

A Georgetown native who had lived in Manitoba since 1913, James Alexander McDowell, 77 died in Killarney General Hospital on October 9th. As a young man he worked in the lime kilns at Limehouse. He married Agnes Isabel Arthur in 1908, and five years later they went west, farming until 1919 at Neepawa, Manitoba and then in the Killarney district. He had farmed at his present home since 1925. He was a member of Calvary Baptist Church. Surviving is one son Frank, five grandsons, five sisters and two brothers. Mrs. Jane Currie, Mrs. Angus Lawson, Mrs. Charlotte Osborne, Will and Harvey of this district, Mrs. Reg Christie, Brampton and Mrs. Alf Marshall, Toronto. 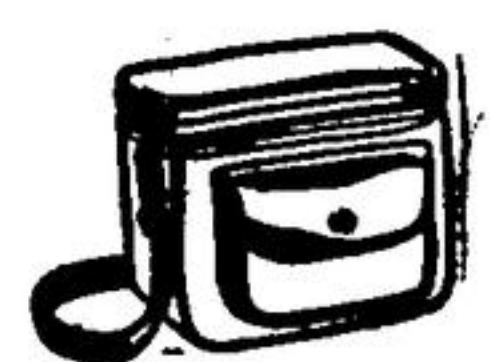
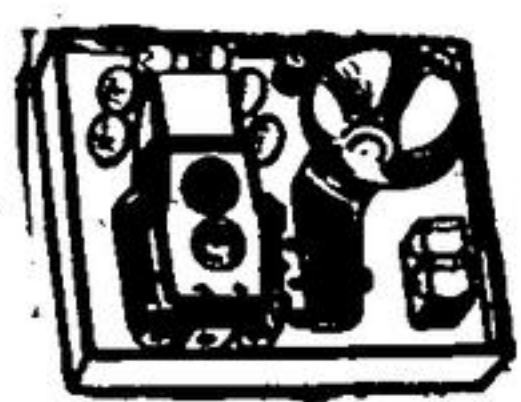
