mayor that if council did not feel competent to judge they would seek major advice.  
"You shouldn't consider buying an article unless you previously decide you want it," continued Mr. Warwick.  
This drew comment from Cr. Cass, who said "How much longer do we have to listen to these rhetorical insults from this gentleman? He's taken twenty minutes to ask a simple question which has been answered at least twice."  
Mr. Warwick then said he wished to suggest that recreation activities in town be centralized under one head with an approved budget. As a member of the Community Centre Association, his group has been struggling to make ends meet, he said, and currently has a \$300 deficit which he is hopeful council will consider paying.  
"We'll leave your request with our recreation committee, but I doubt if it is possible for council to say all sports must come under one head," said Mayor Hyde.
