The Corporation of the Township of Trafalgar

By-Law

No. 1960-21

A By-Law to amend By-Law 1958-48

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to amend the existing By-Laws to provide for certain amendments to permit Residential and Educational Use;

AND WHEREAS the aforesaid amendments heretofore set out were recommended by the Planning Board of the Township of Trafalgar on the 10th day of February, 1960, and the 15th day of September, 1960.

Now therefore the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Trafalgar enacts as follows:

1. That By-Law No. 1958-48, being the zoning by-law of the northern area of this municipality, be and the same is hereby amended as follows:

(a) Following Sub-section 6 of Section 1, the following section be added:

(i) "Educational Uses" shall mean academic schools offering courses of instruction equivalent to those customarily available in such schools under the jurisdiction of a public authority and shall include nur sery schools."

(ii) Section 51 (f) delete all detail and substitute therefore "churches, Sunday Schools and other places of worship with or without church hall and educational uses other than a trade school."
