



Technicians assemble Trans-Canada Air Lines highly complex Douglas DC-8 simulator in the company's new training building at Montreal. The \$1,000,000 machine, built by Link Aviation Company, is capable of doing anything the aircraft can do — steep banks, stalls, spins, simulated random passenger movement and the average in flight. The simulator will be used to supplement training of pilots for the 500-mile-an-hour, 127-passenger DC-8, a cutting-edge and having the aircraft themselves live for training purposes. More than 120 miles of wire, some three and a half inches in diameter and hundreds of amplifiers and servomotors are included in the simulator complex, which has been built on the largest and most complete in the world. TCA pilots began training on the simulator at the end of February.

Lower Auto Insurance Rates

A 10 per cent rate reduction on small and compact cars is being introduced in Ontario this week by State Farm Mutual Automobile Insurance Company.

Eric Beard, local agent for State Farm, also announced a reduction in liability rates for nearly two-thirds of the family policy holders in Ontario.

Most models of the Rambler, Lark, Convar, Falcon, Valiant, all Volkswagens and Beetles and many other cars qualify for the reduction.
