Theatreman Killed in Crash Near Milton

Two Milton men met their death last Wednesday when their car was fatally involved with a tractor-trailer loaded with a load of cement.

Dead are Murray Nason age 26 and John Gaulton, 61. The truck driver, Daniel McNeil, 47, of South Ave. Woodhurst, was treated for head injuries at Milton District Hospital after his vehicle landed on it, which landed on a school bus.

Mrs. Nason and Mr. Gaulton both were thrown from the car when it attempted a left turn on the 25th Highway on No. 5 Highway and collided with the approaching truck.

Mrs. Nason, four owner and operator of what is now the Milton Bus, in recent years was in the real estate business. He owned a small laundry through Mrs. Gaulton's care.

Mrs. Gaulton, who was driving the Nason car, was uninjured.

Police are investigating the cause of the crash.
