Consider Three Sites for Proposed New County Building

\$750,000 Structure is Debated By Council

An estimated cost of \$750,000 submitted by the county building committee of county council for a proposed new building, jolted the members considerably at this month's county council meeting in Milton.

Replying to a question from A. Service Nassagaweya, chairman of the building committee, Dearynes explained that the Administration of Justice would also be moved into the new building.
