## "Wording Is Misleading" Says Council, Orders Sign Removed

A new sign erected by Delrex Developments Ltd. on its highway office building was ordered removed after a six-hour council debate Monday.

A Hunter-Kelly motion to refuse permission to the firm to erect a sign and calling for immediate removal, brought varying opinions from councilors. While some agreed that the sign was misleading, four councilors felt that council action was too arbitrary and that objections should first be referred with the case.

Reeve Sargent advised a recorded vote would be taken. Deputy Reeve Gertie Gies, Gies and Gunn opposed the motion, while three others voted no.

The matter had received council attention a week ago when a letter from the Delrex firm mentioned that they had erected an extremely tall first asking council's permission as required by the zoning by-law. "The law says there can only be signs above a building, and any other must be okayed by council."

At that time C. H. Hunter registered strong objection to the wording of the sign which includes the phrase "Member of Georgetown Chamber of Commerce and Georgetown Industrial Commission."

This could indicate that the offices of these groups are

located in the building, he concluded.

Reeve Sargent pointed out that other by-laws state commercial buildings may not have signs on them.

C. H. Kelly said that if he were asked to erect a sign he would look up the regulations before erecting it.

"We've spent too much time on this particular sign," said C. H. Elliott. "If we're going to tell others to take down signs, we'll have to do the same with Delrex."

Before the motion was called for a vote, Mayor Hyde said that if Delrex came and asked for permission for another sign and indicated any information that is agreeable to the parties mentioned, it would receive consideration.
