## Tractor Blaze Calls Local Fire Department

He battled the blaze with four powder extinguishers until firemen arrived to douse it with water off the pump truck. Chief Bob Bonfield made no estimate of the total damage but said the tractor would need four new tires, painting and rewiring as well as a new seat.

The tractor was standing beside the gas storage tank when the fire occurred. The alarm was turned in at about 1:45 p.m.
