**NATO Formations Leads In  
Army Accident Prevention**

Eastern Ontario was the  
forefront of an important tro-  
phy presentation at Headquar-  
ters of the 4th Canadian Infan-  
try Brigade Group, when Brig-  
adier Donald C. Cameron of  
Alexandria accepted the Pear-  
kes trophy won by our NATO  
formation by leading all serv-  
ices in a vehicle accident preven-  
tion.

The 20-inch gilt and marble  
plated trophy was presen-  
ted to the Brigade Commander  
by Lt. Col. T. W. Bigelow, of  
Ottawa, on behalf of the Min-  
ister of National Defence, Hon.  
George Pearkes, VC.

The trophy, offered for an  
annual competition by all three  
services, Navy, Army and Air  
Force, and Defence Research  
Board, was originally given to  
the Minister by the Automotive  
Transport Association for Onta-  
rio for military participation in  
the annual truck races.

The presentation ceremony  
was held at the headquarters of  
the 4th Canadian Infantry  
Brigade Group, 4th Canadian  
Infantry Brigade, in February,  
1955. In November 1957, his  
brigade took over as Canada's  
NATO formation in Germany.

In congratulating Brigadier  
Cameron and the drivers who  
headed the accident prevention  
campaign, the army's quar-  
termaster general, Major General,  
Robert Munce, wrote: "That  
brigade group should be able to  
qualify for this trophy, despite  
the many millions of miles trav-  
elled by your vehicles is a proof  
of a most conscientious and  
successful effort to achieve  
a high standard of driving skill.  
Please convey my congratula-  
tions to all those who contrib-  
uted to your success."

The German accident preven-  
tion program, continually  
strengthened with drivers of the  
brigade and which was responsible  
for the 1959 award, would  
award safety stickers to the  
major and minor unit which es-  
tablishes the best record over a  
three-month period. It also  
provides careful military and civil-  
ian drivers with lapel pins and  
24, 48 and 72 hour special hold-  
ings. Such as long as it re-  
mains in Europe, the Pearkes  
Trophy will honour the major  
unit with the best three month  
record.

accepted the trophy on behalf
