**New Association Handles All Local Baseball Teams**

Representatives from Georgetown's three baseball organizations have met to form the Georgetown Baseball Association.

The objects of the association, laid down at the meeting are:

- To foster and improve baseball in Georgetown.
- To protect and promote the mutual interests of all members.
- To institute and regulate baseball financially and otherwise in Georgetown.

**Bill Richmond** was elected to head the association while **Bill Smith** was named vice president and **Norm Macklem**, secretary treasurer. Representing the new Intermediate A Club are **Scotty Patterson**, **Bill Fisher** and **Myles Gilson**; **Haltontown County League** Midgets, **Bill Richmond**, **Tracy Barringer**, and **Phil Poyntz**; and **Local Minor Ball**, **Bill Smith**, **Norm Macklem** and **Star Walsh**.

The intermediates will have use of the new hardball diamond Wednesday and Saturday; **County Midgets**, Friday and Sunday; and **Minor Ball**, Tuesday and Thursday.

**NAVIGATES AUSTIN IN RALLY**

One of North America's top sports car drivers, **Georgetown's Grant Clarke**, was in one of the eighty-five cars that finished the **Trans-Canada Car Rally** in **Vancouver** on the weekend.

**Grant** and a **Toronto** driver **Fred Hayes**, who made up part of the **Austin** team negotiated the 4,400 miles from **Montreal** to **Vancouver** in an **Austin A99** which ran faultlessly for the full seven days of the gruelling trip. One hundred and six cars started the rally.

Though not normally a rallyist, **Grant**, has had rally experience in a winter rally two years ago which he came close to winning. His chances in this one were damped right at the start when they missed a check point near **Montreal** that cost him two hundred points. **Fred Hayes** handled the driving all the way while **Grant** navigated.

The rally, the first of its type here, was sponsored by the **British Columbia Trade Fair** and the **Shell Oil Company** and will be held annually. This year's test was won by the team of **Jack Young** and **Reg Hillary** in a **Lark**.

The cars made over night stops in **Toronto**, **Port Arthur**, **Winnipeg**, **Regina**, **Calgary**, and **Penticton**. In terms of hours the longest run was from **Calgary** to **Penticton**. The route took cars north to **Banff** and through **Kicking Horse Pass** to **Golden**, **B.C.** before turning south for a harrowing climb through the **Cascades**.

The climb was made in pitch darkness through rain, snow and mist and carried cars up 5,200 feet over a single lane that clung to the mountainside. There were two accidents resulting in one fatality.

**Challenge Trophy Returns**
